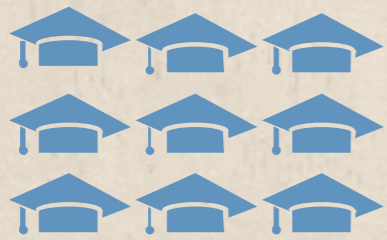

Iran faces a dearth of over 45,000 hospital beds. The estimated cost for each additional hospital bed is \$139,535.00



THE RIGHT TO HOUSING

435,438 NEW HOMES

The cost of construction is based on the current price of \$279 per square meter for urban dwellings. The average area per dwelling in Iran is 100 square meters.

According to official statistics, there are 10 million slum-dwellers in Iran, and the number of people leaving in informal housing has risen seventeen-fold over the last 30 years.
