**Renee C. Redman** is Executive Director of the Iran Human Rights Documentation Center (IHRDC) in New Haven, Connecticut. Prior to joining IHRDC, Attorney Redman practiced immigration law at New Haven Legal Assistance Association and served as Legal Director of the ACLU of Connecticut. Until 2004, she practiced commercial litigation with Hughes Hubbard & Reed, LLP in New York City. She clerked for the Immigration Courts in New York City and Newark, New Jersey, and the Honorable Warren W. Eginton of the United States District Court in Bridgeport, Connecticut. She is an Adjunct Professor at Quinnipiac and University of Connecticut Schools of Law.
