

Eight Executed in Iran

TEHRAN—Eight persons were executed in the Persian Gulf refinery town of Abadan on charges of armed rebellion, receiving guerrilla training and sabotaging oil installations.

Five of those executed were believed to be members of Abadan's ethnic Arab community.

Eleven persons were killed and 30 injured when antigovernment rebels and unidentified bombers struck in the Kurdish provinces and in the oil-rich border region of Khuzestan.

Egypt, U.S. Sign Aid Pact

CAIRO—Egypt and the United States signed an agreement under which the United States will provide Egypt with up to 1.4 million metric tons of wheat and wheat flour worth \$243 million. A metric ton is 2,200 pounds.

Egypt will repay the loan over 40 years at an undisclosed rate of interest and will have a 10-year grace period.
