Teheran (Reuter)—Rebel Kurds yeserday besieged an Iranian gendarmerie
oost near the Iraqi border after launching
vernight hit-and-run raids in which at
east 13 persons were killed, a gendarnerie spokesman said.

The spokesman in the south Kurdish ity of Kermanshah said about 40 government troops were holding out against several hundred guerrillas at the Hanigar-

neleh frontier post.

He said communications with the post had been cut and latest details of the fighting were not known. It was not clear whether there were gendarmes or revolutionary guards or both inside. Both are government troops.
