Dracula's ghost haunts court in California

From Ivor Davis, Los Angeles, Dec 4. The ghost of a fiend's Court Dracula has haunted the California Supreme Court for two years but to no avail.

Justices in a close 4 to 3 decision have ruled that the heirs of Bela Lugosi, the actor who played the blood-thirsty count, and no exclusive rights to commercial exploitation of the actor's portrayal of the Transylvanian vampire count which was created by Bram Stoker in his 1897 novel 'Dracula'.

In a long-awaited verdict the court ruled in favour of Universal Pictures. The Lugosi family had claimed a large estate of profits made by the studio from selling Dracula masks, tee shirts and other novelty items after the actor's death in 1956.
