

MPs condemn western interference in Iran

215 Iranian members of Parliament on Wednesday condemned the US, UK and France's interference in the Iranian domestic affairs.

They rejected the western states' meddling in Iranian domestic affairs citing the western support for the post-election unrests in the country.

The MPs said in a petition that such actions practiced by the western governments accounted for violation of international laws.

They reiterated that the era of interference in national affairs of other countries is over as the 30-year-old history of the Islamic Revolution proved.

The parliamentarians said that the Islamic Republic of Iran will give tough response to foreign interference. A response that it will be unforgettable to the colonialist mindset of the US and UK.
